

Conway Festival of the Hills Scholarship Application

Conway Festival of the Hills Scholarships are awarded to all graduating Conway seniors, regardless of their post graduate plans. Seniors must complete this application to be eligible for an award. The distribution of funds will be determined based on the point system below. (The points are the maximum attainable in each category.)

1. Community service and extracurricular activities - 7 points
2. Academic achievement - 4 points
3. Financial need and effort at self-sufficiency - 2 points
4. School report and transcripts - 2 points
5. Complete application (see checklist) - 1 point
