

## Conway Festival of the Hills Scholarship Application

Conway Festival of the Hills Scholarships are awarded to all graduating Conway seniors, regardless of their post graduate plans. Seniors must complete this application to be eligible for an award. The distribution of funds will be determined based on the point system below, with a maximum total of 23 points. (The points are the maximum attainable in each category.)

1. Community service - 5 points
2. Extracurricular activity – 5 points
3. Academic achievement - 5 points
4. Household income/ financial need – 4 points
5. Work history – 2 points
6. Festival of the Hills service – 2 points
